TO WHOM IT MAY CONFIRM TOUR DATES WITH 10 YEARS FRESH OFF THE ROAD WITH CANDLEBOX PLAYING SOLD OUT SHOWS

Galveston, TX (March 19, 2019) – Hot off the heels of a 12 date tour with Candlebox, progressive metal and hard rock trio To Whom It May (TWIM) are headed back on the road later this month with 10 Years. Having played to sold out shows in Florida and filling venues like The Fillmore Detroit, Chicago House of Blues, 20 Monroe Live, TWIM are quickly establishing themselves as a must see act.

Comprised of members Jonathan Jourdan (vocals/guitar), Robb Mars (bass), and Dexas Villarreal (drums), TWIM bring a rare blend of heaviness and commercialism with their hard-rocking complex, groove infested sound. The vocals have an almost Brandon Boyd/Incubus quality to them that plays to the hipster and mainstream audiences but it's layered over heavy, melodic music that any fan of the Breaking Benjamin, Five Finger Death Punch, Stone Sour type of sound will gravitate to.

On the road promoting their debut album "The Great Filter," TWIM have charted to iTunes Metal #10 and Billboard Heatseekers #10. "The album took around 3 years from start to finish," explains Jourdan. "It was an experimental process for us, because the project was so new. We wanted to be able to look at the record in 10 years and still be content with the outcome. My favorite track on the album changes every day, but "Calculate" is a favorite at the moment. It's our current single, and hearing an audience sing along during the show is a moving event."
